

# APA Research Paper

## Structure

The body of your research paper:

- **Title Page:** sample available
- **Abstract:** a brief summary of the paper, allowing readers to quickly review the main points and purpose of paper ( $\frac{1}{2}$  - **1 page**)
- **Introduction/background:** presents the research question and problem that the paper addresses (**2 - 3 pages**)
- **Problem statement:** state the problem associated with your research topic/question; pose the research question and objectives and be specific to the problems in which your research paper is associated with the question you performed (**1 - 2 pages**)
- **Methods:** states the participants, population, demographics and variables measured in your journal articles (**1 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  pages PER study**)
- **Results:** describe what you found in your research studies, not whether it answered your question (**1page PER study**) (**graphs and data can be included here**)
- **Discussion:** restate the overall purpose of the study and explain the main findings; discusses the limitations of articles studied (**1-3 pages**)
- **Conclusion:** restates the problem the paper addresses ( $\frac{1}{2}$  - **1 page**)
- **Reference page** (separate page) sources used in research paper
  
- Headers are going to be in bold.
- APA Format: 12 font, Times New Roman
- Please **DO NOT** use **I or We** in your research paper.
